SERVICE NOTE

WELCOME - The second Sunday of Easter is also known as Low Sunday as it comes at the end of Easter week, but rather than a Sunday to retire from and fold away the alleluias, it is a Sunday that speaks of bolder confidence and assurance from the disciples. On Easter Day the disciples are in the upper room afraid and unsure. This week the focus passage has them proclaiming confidently of Christ Jesus risen. (Ecumenical Prayer Calendar: East Timor, Indonesia, Philippines.)
