WELCOME! Salt is essential to life as it allows for the proper function of the human body along with the other life forms on earth. We think of salt as a seasoning, but it also serves as a preservative and disinfectant. Salt is a common substance, and in Jesus' day it was highly valued, even serving as a unit of exchange. In the gospel passage for today, those listening to Jesus' Sermon on the Mount are told that they are like the salt of the earth. Together, we will explore how we can preserve and purify and be both common and essential; and learn what it means to "practice righteousness" and to restore beauty in community.
