WE GATHER AS GOD'S PEOPLE

THE MUSICAL PRELUDE:

One: We join with the atmosphere in worship:

All: the air, the moisture, the oxygen, the wind and all the expressions of God's Spirit.

One: We call the clouds to celebrate with storms:

All: to carry the life giving drops of rain, that give hope and healing to Earth.

One: We invite the winds to join our petitions:

All: to carry our prayers to God above and breathe our hopes to Christ in person.

One: We celebrate the song of the skies!

All: Sing! Skies! Sing!

One: Let us worship God!

We acknowledge the need for repentance and beyond repentance the need for action to preserve the life giving force of the atmosphere. 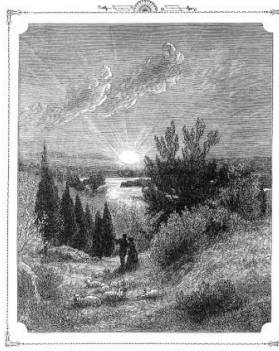
